WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS:

"THE SHADOW OF WORK" – How to implement staff mobility at your university. How do you motivate your colleagues to attend international staff weeks or language courses? How to find the right counterpart of a willing candidate to attend a "work shadowing?" How do you find out which agent or institution will serve your staff mobilities best? Can you trust a list of offerings if access is not safeguarded?

"LOST IN ADMINISTRATION" – The Curse of Data management in handling international mobilities worldwide. Harvesting data regarding international mobility can be excessively time consuming and tedious, but does it actually help anyone or is it simply another burden for your staff?
